• **Meet Blake.** Blake lived a life of drugs for most of his life He was incarcerated in the Benton Detention Center where he met Jesus Christ, thanks to the faithful jail ministers who loved him out of the kingdom of darkness into the Kingdom of Light. Today Blake works full time at Freedom Seekers, a faith-based ministry that takes men like Blake out of the cycle of being in and out of jail and provides them with a transitional living alternative to returning to their old environment.
